Lancaster University College at Beijing Jiaotong University

(LUC@BJTU) is a joint institute, established in partnership by Beijing Jiaotong University in China and Lancaster University in the UK. The campus is located at Nanhai New District, Weihai, Shandong province, on the east coast of China between Beijing and Shanghai. The courses are taught by Lancaster University and BJTU academics. Graduates will receive the qualification from two leading UK and Chinese universities, as well as a joint academic transcript.



LUC@BJTU Campus

Lancaster University (LU) was founded in 1964 and is now regarded as being one of the top institutions in the UK. It is a campus university located in North West England. It is ranked in the top 10 across all national league tables of UK universities. LU was also awarded University of the Year by The Times and Sunday Times Good University Guide (2018). The university is ranked 131st in the QS World University Rankings (2019). The research is recognized as world-leading and the Teaching Excellence Framework Gold award in 2017 shows that the teaching is of the highest quality found in the UK.

Beijing Jiaotong University (BJTU) was founded in 1896 as one of the three original Jiatong Universities in China. BJTU is a national key university in China. BJTU is one of the first universities selected into the “National 211 Project” and the “985 Innovative Platforms for Key Disciplines Project”. BJTU has established the Collaborative Innovation Centre for Rail Transit Safety, which is one of the first 14 collaborative centres selected by the Chinese government into the “National 2011 Projects”. In 2017, BJTU was selected into the ‘Double First-Class’ National Initiative.



BJTU enters the four major world university rankings, including THE World University Ranking and the Academic Ranking of World University for the first time, with the international ranking steadily improving. Three disciplines were ranked 1% in the ESI ranking, including Engineering ranked top 1.5%. Ten disciplines were ranked top 500 in the Academic Ranking of World University by discipline, including Traffic and Transportation Engineering ranked 1st in China 2nd worldwide, Communication Engineering ranked 10th in China and 38th worldwide.

Students at LU – according to the latest National Student Survey (2018) – are more satisfied with their course than the average student. 88% of Lancaster University students are satisfied overall – compared with a national average of 83 per cent. This puts Lancaster in the top of UK universities. Dedicated careers staff and initiatives such as the Lancaster Award, 89% of Lancaster students going into professional work or further education after graduation. According to the same survey, Times and Sunday Times Good University Guide 2019, LU is the 3rd in the UK for graduate-level employment in the same survey. LU is one of only six institutions nationwide to achieve the International Accommodation Quality Mark – awarded to those whose satisfaction among international students was at 90% or higher. The university has also won the ‘Best University Halls’ in the prestigious National Student Housing Awards seven times since 2010, contributing to the overall student experience and satisfaction.

BJTU campus in Beijing has an area of nearly 67 hectares. In September 2015, the Weihai International Campus of BJTU in Weihai, Shandong Province came into service. All campuses have complete teaching and research facilities and beautiful environments.

Academic entry requirement

- A Level - BBB (BBC is also considered)
- AP - 444 (443 is also considered)
- International Baccalaureate - 30 points overall including 15 points from 3 HL's
- Mongolia - Completion of the Upper Secondary Education (Gerchilgee) with a minimum score of 4/5
- South Korea - Senior High School Certificate with a minimum grade of 70% overall

English language requirement

- IELTS - overall 5.5 with at least 5.5 in each element
- TOEFL (iBT) - 72 overall with at least 18 in Reading, 17 in Listening, 20 in Speaking, 17 in Writing
- International Baccalaureate - Either 5 in Higher Level English or 6 in Standard level English

Accommodation & Canteen

- Double room with bathroom, public kitchen and laundry on each level. The room is furnished with two single beds and bedding, desks, bookshelves, closet, air-conditioner, refrigerator and internet cable.
- Accommodation cost - CNY 10,000 per academic year
- 3-story canteen provide breakfast, lunch, and dinner with more than 80 choices every day
- Meal - approximately CNY 10,000 per academic year at campus canteen

- Receive offer letters and register as the students at both Beijing Jiaotong University and Lancaster university
- Receive a degree from both Beijing Jiaotong University and Lancaster university
- Courses are taught by both Lancaster University academics and Beijing Jiaotong University academics.
- Alumni status for application to postgraduate programmes at both Beijing Jiaotong University and Lancaster University
- Graduates will be well-equipped for work or further study by world-wide recognized degrees and immersion in UK and Chinese academic cultures
